## Victim Advocacy

Victim Services Coordinators will assist victims of crime through direct service provisions such as linking victims to resources that will serve their physical, emotional and basic needs. This program strives to promote the dignity and self-sufficiency of victims.



As a result of increased coordination through community awareness the rate of reporting sexual assault, domestic dating violence and stalking will increase the rate of evidence based prosecution of these cases through evidence collection, training and documentation.
